- **Growing Project for Growing Hope Globally:** We're making progress in raising funds to help people grow more and better food in the Western Highlands of Guatemala! Please note, this program is in the 1st year of a 5 year phase, which is why we don't have personal impact stories to share yet. **In Totonicapan, Guatemala, a macho culture prevails, which often means that women have little access to and ownership of the means of production.** They also have **less access to education and health services**. Migration abroad is becoming a decision that women and young people are making in the face of a lack of opportunities for advancement, placing them in a position of high vulnerability and risk. Indigenous women in Guatemala suffer triple discrimination: for being women, for being Indigenous, and for being poor or from rural areas. **The conditions for young people are difficult because most do not have employment opportunities**, their participation in community assemblies is minimal because their opinions are not listened to, and **their level of vulnerability is high** because, in the presence of criminal structures in other departments, they are at risk of being recruited and led into illegal activities. That is why it is important to listen to them, organize them, and promote economic alternatives that harness their energy and enthusiasm to improve their living conditions. Please consider donating to this worthy cause.
